



## **February Update**

Dear parents/carers,

I wanted to write to update you on a few things coming up in the next weeks.

### **School Restart**

You will have seen on the media last week that schools have now been instructed to continue offering remote learning until returning to school on **Monday 8<sup>th</sup> March**. We have been told that this return date is being kept under review and will be confirmed by the Department of Education closer to the time.

As a school, we want to pay tribute to you and say thank you for all of your support during this recent period of remote learning. We know that learning at home is not easy and we appreciate how well you are all doing. Please remember that we are here to support you in any way we can – please get in touch if you need anything.

### **Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February – Screen Free Friday**

We're conscious that families and staff are spending more time using screens and devices during this period of remote learning. Whilst this offers many benefits, we also want to encourage adults and children to manage their screen time. On Friday 5<sup>th</sup> February, I have asked teachers to step away from their screens for the day and have asked them to set activities for the children that are not based on SeeSaw. As children will not be using screens for their learning, I have asked staff to work on other tasks that days, so they will not be able to respond through SeeSaw as they normally would. We hope this day will give you as a family the opportunity to do something different and experience learning in a different form.

### **Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> February – Wednesday Blog**

Normally, when children are using SeeSaw they don't see work that other children have produced. In our recent survey children said they would like to get the opportunity to see some of their classmates' work and engage with them. So, on Wednesday 10<sup>th</sup> February, the only activity set will be on a SeeSaw blog, designated just for your child's class. Their teachers will explain how they use the blog in more detail, but basically they will share a piece of work from their remote learning and get the opportunity to see and comment on what others have been doing. We hope it's a really positive experience and would encourage you to help your child use the blog.

### **Friday 12<sup>th</sup> February – School Development Day**

There will be no remote learning on this day for the children. Teachers will be preparing material for the remote learning that is taking place after our half-term break.
